FIRE PROCEDURE

- 1. If you find a fire, ring the red bell in the yard or tell staff immediately.
- 2. Stay calm.
- 3. Walk off the site and wait in the car park.
- 4. Our staff fire warden will tick you off the list.
- 5. Do not go back into the site to collect anything.
- 6. If the fire brigade are called, keep out of their way so they can do their job.
- 7. Do not go back inside until you are given the all clear by the staff fire warden or fire officer.

OUR LOCATION AND FACILITIES

Our two sites, totalling over seven acres, are located in a beautiful, countryside location, near the market town of Melton Mowbray in Leicestershire.

We are a licenced riding establishment (no. RE009) and licenced camp site with Melton Borough Council.

Although this is not a secure site, our boundaries are well-fenced for safety. We have large carpark areas which can accommodate several vehicles.

Facilities include heated log cabins with kitchen, seating and learning areas, toilet and shower facilities, natural sensory rooms, barns with large internal stables, all-weather manèges, chicken coops, goat pens, play paddocks, and several horse paddocks.
